LEGAL SERVICES ARE CRITICAL TO EMPOWERMENT

2231 individual cases were opened, of which

85% were male, 15% were female and 20% were older veterans

41 mobile clinics at the VA Hospital Long Beach, Starbucks Coffee, Saddleback College, OC Veterans Service Office, North County Vet Center and the City of Mission Viejo

30% of cases addressed veterans benefits and discharge upgrades

270 individual cases were dedicated to keeping veterans in their homes

HOMELESS, LOW-INCOME VETERANS & MILITARY FAMILIES FACE SIGNIFICANT AND DIVERSE CHALLENGES

19 to 103 is the age range of our veterans, with an average age of 42

1140 children were supported through empowering their veteran parent(s)

Veterans who are single have an average income \$1790 per month or less

Military families of 4 have an average income of \$3130 per month or less

\$1800 is the median rent in Southern California
